1	Shower seat or bath lift is available if needed for stability.	
2	Grab bars are securely installed in the shower and tub areas.	
	GENERAL PRECAUTIONS & MAINTENANCE	
1	Water heater is set to safe temperature to prevent scalding (ideally around 120°F or 48.9°C).	
2	Medications are stored in a designated area, out of reach of children and clearly labeled.	
3	Waterproof alert device is installed for immediate assistance if needed.	
4	Regularly inspect all pipes, faucets, and toilets to prevent water hazards.	
5	Ensure all seals are intact to prevent slips and falls.
